HOW WE WORK

One team, from first drawing to final fit

01 Design & drawings

We develop the design in 3D CAD, working through every elevation with you or your design team before anything is made.

02 Survey

A measured site survey ensures everything fits the building precisely — essential in period and existing homes.

03 Make

Components are made in our Suffolk workshop, combining CNC precision with hand craftsmanship and finishing.

04 Finish

Hand-applied paint and polish, quality ironmongery and integrated lighting, completed in controlled conditions.

05 Install

Our own team installs the work, scribing to the building and protecting the finish — a clean, efficient programme on site.

Working with architects & designers

Most of our work comes through the trade, and we understand what design teams need: accurate delivery to drawings, reliable timescales, discreet conduct on site, and the confidence that an unusual detail will be solved rather than refused. We can join a project early to develop and resolve the joinery detail, and we are happy to be credited and linked on your project pages.

MATERIALS & SUSTAINABILITY

Made well, made to last

We select timber and veneers for grain, stability and longevity, building on solid framing and well-made carcasses with quality ironmongery throughout. Pieces are made and finished in controlled workshop conditions so they arrive ready to install cleanly alongside other trades.

Sustainability runs through the business: solar panels on the workshop roofs, EV charging, and waste timber used for heating. Building joinery to last for decades — rather than to be replaced — is itself the most sustainable approach we can take.
