Handmade Bespoke Doors & Door Sets

The most-used piece of joinery in any house — we build ours to take it. Drawn, made and fitted by our own team in Suffolk.

Three door styles. One Suffolk workshop.

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Doors built to be used every day, for decades.

Reeve & Co designs, draws, makes and installs bespoke timber doors for period townhouses, listed buildings, country houses and architect-designed new builds — made in our own Suffolk workshop and fitted by our own team, nothing sub-contracted.

Every door is built with mortice-and-tenon construction, solid timber stiles and rails, and panels in solid timber or veneered MDF for stability. Glazed with single, double or slim-line units where required, then painted, oiled, stained or French-polished.

Front doors, internal doors, glazed doors, double doors and secret doors hidden within panelling — drawn to match existing period joinery or made from your architect's schedule.

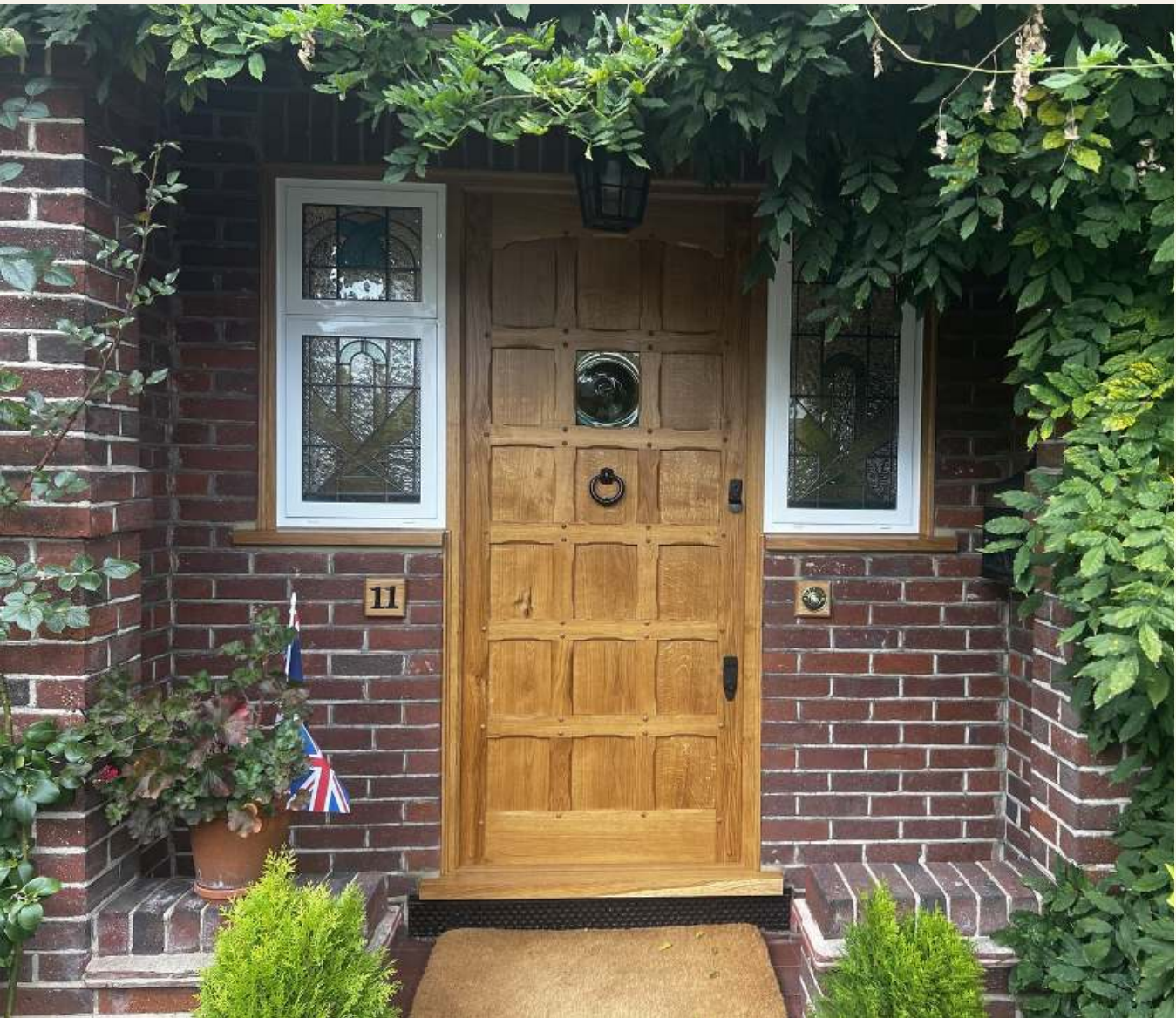

Mortice-and-tenon construction, built for daily use.

Every door is built with mortice-and-tenon joints, solid timber stiles and rails, and panels in solid timber or veneered MDF for stability across the seasons. Oak, walnut, mahogany or painted hardwood, finished by hand to a furniture-grade standard.

We measure original doors and reproduce them exactly for conservation and listed-building projects, and we can build to your architect's schedule from scratch for new work. Concealed jib doors and doors within panelling are built to the same standard as our front and internal doors.

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Front, Internal & Fire Doors

Front and internal doors share the same solid-timber, mortice-and-tenon construction — oak, walnut, mahogany or painted hardwood, finished by hand and built to take daily use for decades rather than years.

Internal doors can be built with a solid engineered core to meet fire-rating requirements (typically FD30) where regulations call for it, in the same profiles and finishes as the rest of the run — please confirm your specific certification requirements with us at quotation stage.

Glazed & Double Doors

Glazed with single, double or slim-line units to suit the building, and built as generous multi-door sets where a room calls for it — a common request for garden doors, orangeries and formal reception rooms.

Every glazed door is built with the same solid-timber stiles and rails as our solid doors, so the glazing bars and proportions sit comfortably alongside period joinery elsewhere in the house.

Secret & Panelled Doors

Concealed jib doors and doors hidden within panelling, built and hung to disappear into the room — hinges, architraves and mouldings all matched so the join is invisible when closed.

A regular request for country houses and high-end interiors, whether for a discreet study, a wine store, or simply to keep a run of panelling unbroken.

Every door in this brochure was surveyed, drawn, made and fitted by the same small Suffolk team — nothing sub-contracted, nothing off the shelf.

Nothing sub-contracted

Survey, design, joinery and installation are all carried out by our own team, so the person who measures your opening is accountable for the door that hangs in it.

Made to the room, not a catalogue

Every door is drawn to your opening and your architect's schedule — standard sizes, period proportions or an exact match to an existing door, all built the same way.

Listed-building experience

We regularly measure and reproduce original doors exactly for conservation and listed-building projects, working alongside conservation officers and architects.

Furniture-grade finishing

Painted, oiled, stained or French-polished by hand to the same standard as our fitted furniture and joinery — not a production-line lacquer finish.

Before you get in touch.

Can you build fire-rated doors?

Yes — internal doors can be built with a solid engineered core to meet fire-rating requirements such as FD30, in the same profiles and finishes as the rest of your door run. Confirm your specific certification needs with us at quotation stage.

Do you match existing doors exactly?

Yes — for restoration and listed-building work we measure and photograph the originals and reproduce panels, mouldings and ironmongery to match.

What timbers do you use?

Oak, walnut, mahogany or painted hardwood as standard, with panels in solid timber or veneered MDF for stability where appropriate.

How long does a door commission take?

Lead times typically run 8–14 weeks in the workshop from approved drawings, depending on scope, plus survey and design time upfront.

Can doors be hidden within panelling?

Yes — concealed jib doors and secret doors are a regular request, built and hung so the join disappears when the door is closed.

Which areas do you cover?

We design, make and install across London, the Home Counties and East Anglia from our Suffolk workshop, with further afield by arrangement.

Do you fit the doors yourselves?

Yes. Survey, drawings, making and installation are all carried out by our own team — nothing is sub-contracted.

What deposit do you take?

Typically 30% on order, 40% at manufacture start, 30% on completion — set out clearly in your quote before anything is made.



How to begin.

Every door commission starts with a conversation about the house, the brief and any listed-building constraints. Send us a schedule from your architect, photographs of an existing door to match, or simply a brief, and we will price within a week.

- **Get in touch** — call, email or use the contact form to tell us about your doors.
- **Consultation** — we discuss the brief, any listed-building requirements, and budget.
- **Survey & drawings** — an accurate site survey followed by design drawings, approved before manufacture.
- **Manufacture & installation** — made bench-by-bench in our Suffolk workshop, fitted by our own team.
