Reeve & Co Interiors is a bespoke joinery workshop founded by Torben Reeve in 2015, designing and hand-making staircases, fitted furniture and architectural joinery for private clients, architects and main contractors across London, the Home Counties and East Anglia.

Design, technical drawing, manufacture and finishing all happen under one roof — nothing that matters to the finished result is left to chance. Every project follows the same five stages: brief and survey, CAD design and drawings, precision machining, bench assembly and hand-finishing, then installation on site by our trusted fitting teams.

The result is joinery designed to be stripped, refinished and re-fitted decades from now.

Where technology sets the tolerance, and hands set the quality.

We use CNC equipment alongside traditional machining to hold exact, repeatable tolerances — but every joint, shadow gap and grain match is resolved by hand at the bench. We specify fine hardwoods — oak, walnut, sycamore, tulipwood — and decorative veneers, sourced from certified suppliers, with all painting and lacquering carried out in our own spray booth to a furniture-grade standard.

Longevity is our starting point for sustainability: well-made joinery can be repaired and adapted rather than replaced. Our workshop runs five EV charging points, biomass heating from our own timber offcuts, and water-based finishes throughout.

- Low-VOC, water-based paints and lacquers
- Five on-site EV charging points, biomass heating

Veneered and marquetry work — zebrano, rosewood, birdseye maple — is laid and pressed in the workshop, matched panel to panel before polishing.

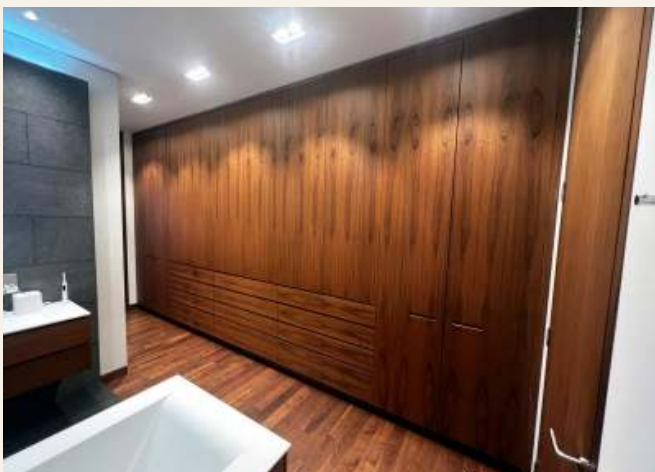

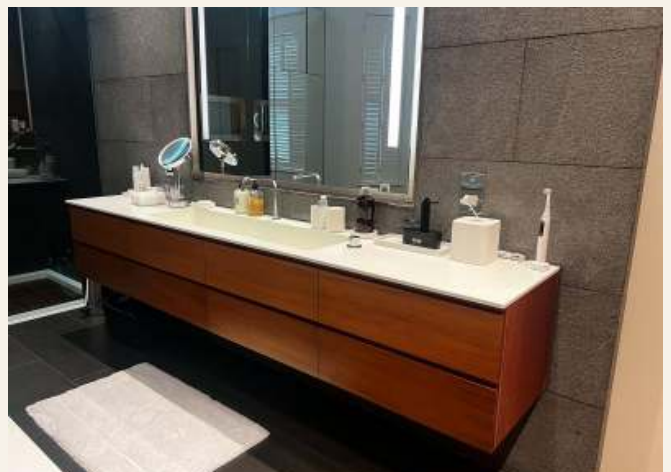
SLOANE SQUARE, LONDON

A turned-baluster oak staircase sets the architectural tone, carried through into arched-panel hallway doors, glazed oak doors with leaded lights and mirrored dressing-room wardrobes — fitted cabinetry and architectural joinery throughout the property.

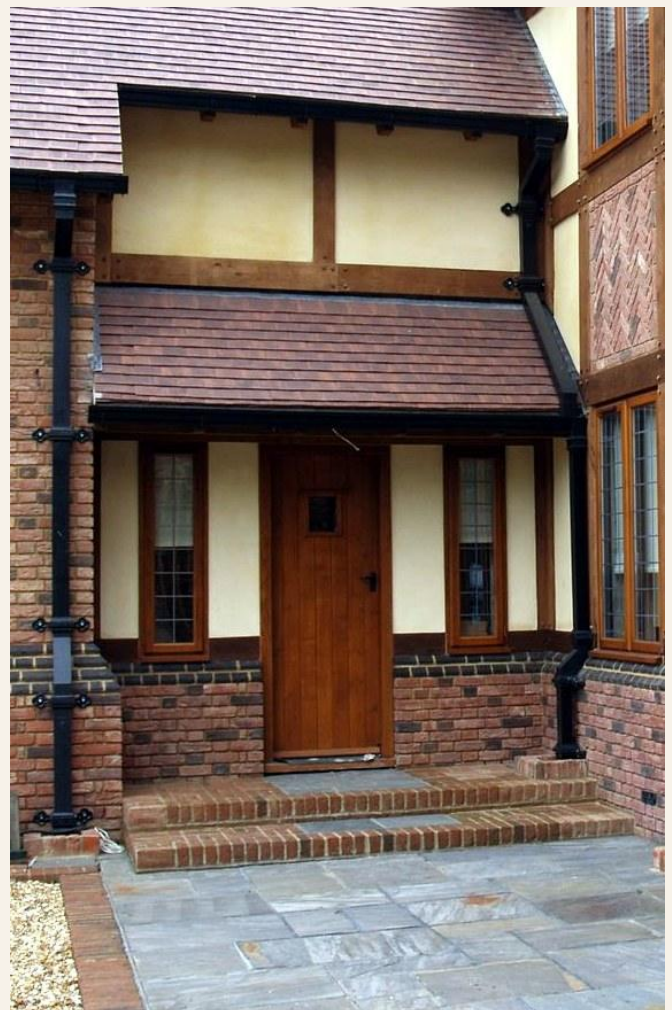
COUNTRY HOUSE

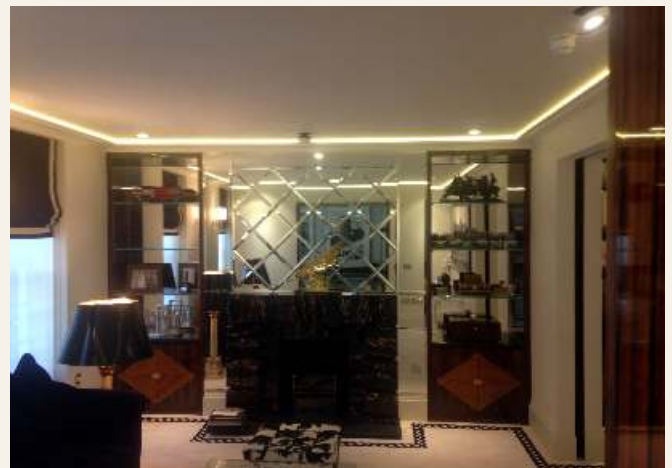

How much does bespoke joinery cost?

Bespoke joinery typically starts around £8,000 for a single fitted piece; freestanding furniture ranges £2,500–£15,000 depending on materials and complexity. Send rough drawings to sales@reeveandco.com for an indicative quote within days.

What's the process from enquiry to handover?

Five stages: consultation, site survey, drawings and an itemised quote, sample approval before cutting, then manufacture in Suffolk and managed installation on site.

Do you work with architects and interior designers?

Yes — a significant share of our work comes through design professionals. We work from RIBA-compatible drawings, attend design meetings, and handle joinery on listed and contract projects.

What deposit do you take?

Freestanding furniture: 50% deposit on order, balance before delivery. Fitted joinery and larger projects: 30% on order, 40% at manufacture start, 30% on completion.

Do you work on listed buildings and period properties?

Yes, regularly — a good share of our joinery is for Grade I and Grade II listed homes, including period-correct restoration, mouldings, panelled rooms and windows.

Can you match an architect's drawings or specification?

Yes — we work directly from architects' drawings, NBS specifications and designer schedules, producing our own shop drawings for approval before manufacture.

Can I get a drawing of a bespoke product before committing?

Yes — our designers produce line drawings quickly, with complete drafting packages for fitted projects.

What timbers and materials do you work with?

Premium European hardwoods — oak, cherry, walnut, ash and tulipwood — plus decorative veneers, stone and metalwork where specified. Paint is sourced from Little Greene and Farrow & Ball.

Do you offer a design-only service?

Occasionally, for architects and designers who want our detailing and drawings but plan to have another workshop manufacture — please ask.

Is your joinery sustainable?

We use FSC- and PEFC-certified European hardwoods where available, finish everything in-house, and select low-VOC paints and oils throughout.

Can I commission just one piece?

Yes — either a single piece or a full whole-house package works equally well for us.

How long will my project take?

Larger fitted and whole-house projects are scheduled around your build programme — typically 6 weeks for smaller items up to around 6 months for large projects.

Do you fit on site?

Yes — our trusted fitting teams install across London, the Home Counties and East Anglia, with other areas by arrangement, managed and quality-checked by us.

Do you have a showroom?

A small showroom with a couple of kitchens and tables, alongside our working workshop — open Monday to Friday, 8am–5pm, Mickfield, near Stowmarket, Suffolk.

How much is delivery and installation?

Free across mainland UK. Non-mainland and international projects are quoted separately.

How do I get a quote?

Send sketches, photos or room dimensions to sales@reeveandco.com, or call 01449 710500 — we aim to come back with an indicative quote within days.

Can you work to a fixed budget?

Yes — tell us the budget up front and we will design and specify to make the most of it, being clear about trade-offs along the way.
